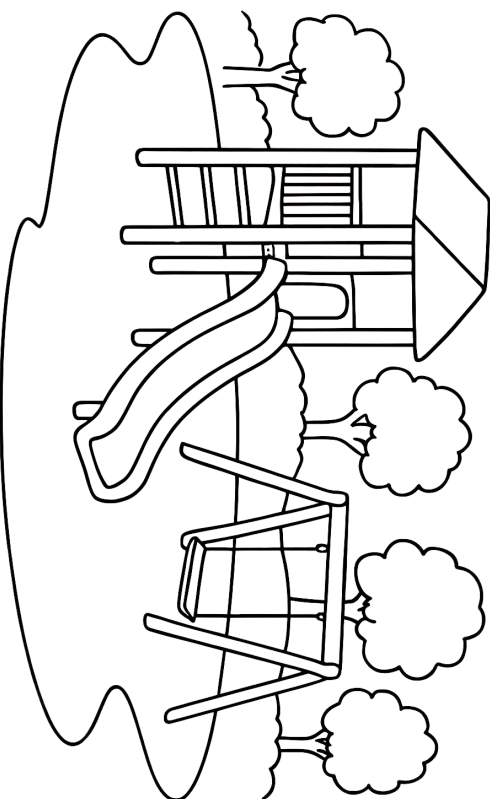

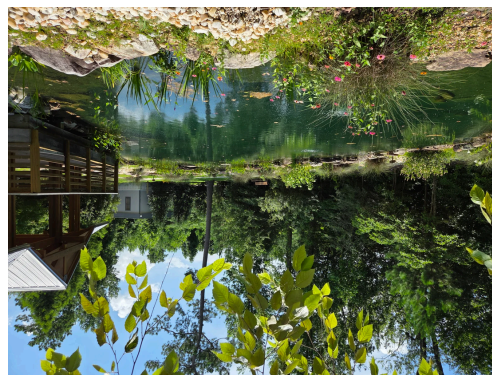

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Discovery Gardens of Onslow County offers families a four-acre educational green space featuring multiple themed garden areas where children and adults can learn about local plants, gardening techniques, and environmental stewardship. The gardens include a dedicated children's area, a nature trail winding through diverse plantings, and a scenic summer house overlooking a small pond that creates a tranquil focal point. Visitors can enjoy recreational activities including horseshoes and shuffleboard in the picnic area, while educational opportunities abound throughout the greenhouse, courtyard, and apiary displays that showcase gardening best practices specific to Onslow County.

Wilson Bay Park

Wilson Bay Park sits along the shoreline of Wilson Bay on the New River system, providing families with waterfront access and recreational amenities in downtown Jacksonville. The park features a playground area where children can enjoy outdoor play, along with a shelter equipped with picnic tables for family gatherings. Visitors can access the waterfront through a boardwalk that extends toward the water, and restrooms are available on-site for convenience. A gazebo provides additional covered space for relaxation while enjoying water views.
